Product Description

Carboxide All Purpose Primer Undercoat is a solvent borne, high build base coat for use on bare or new timber, iron, steel and previously painted surfaces. Contains rust inhibiting pigments and has exceptionally high opacity and a full body. Making it perfect as a filler coat for uneven surfaces or if sanding is required on new timber. Available in Grey, Red or White giving any subsequent top coat assistance in covering power. As a multi-functional primer undercoat it provides superior performance.

How to Apply

Stir the paint with a drill stirrer or wooden baton at least 2" wide. Apply by brush, solvent resistant roller or spray. The product must be thoroughly stirred to give a uniform consistency prior to application. It is recommended that the contents are stirred periodically during application to avoid settlement. Carboxide All Purpose Primer Undercoat is supplied at the correct viscosity for direct brush application. If thinning is required use Palatine White Spirit. See the detailed TDS for further information on preceding and subsequent coatings. In order to obtain the best results it is important that the correct rate of application is achieved. The minimum application temperature is 10°C. The required thickness of the coating may be built up by successive applications when the previous coat is completely dry. Clean tools and equipment with Palatine White Spirit.

Packaging Disposal
