CARBOMAC TARMAc RESTORER

DESCRIPTION

TARMAc RESTORER is a blend of bitumens formulated to restore worn tarmac and asphalt surfaces. It can be used on paths, drives, car parks, etc., to repair small cracks and holes and restore appearance.

BENEFITS

- **Quick drying**

PREPARATION

Remove moss, lichen etc. by scraping and pre-washing with a powerwasher. Thoroughly **clean** so that they are free from loose material. Ensure there are no residues or contaminants on the surface. **Surface must be fully dry** before application, to avoid moisture getting trapped and lifting product.

APPLICATION

Stir well before use. Apply a single thick, even coat using a brush or roller. Repair small holes and cracks by first applying a coat of Tarmac Restorer and then immediately applying a coat of Tarmac Restorer mixed with sand, to form a thick paste.

Drying time: Approximately 5 hours. Rain will delay curing. Protect from rain for 30 minutes after application.

Coverage: 1-2 m² per litre per coat.

CLEANING

Clean tools immediately after use with white spirit

PACKAGING

Packed in 5 litre cans, available in Black or Red. Other sizes available on request
